HOW TO GET TO THE WORKSHOP

The workshop will be held at the Venice International University, Island of San Servolo, Venice (<http://www.univiu.org/>). The island of San Servolo can be reached by public transportation. The public boats n° 20 to San Servolo leave from San Marco, in front of the Londra Palace Hotel, Riva degli Schiavoni (the boat stop is called **San Zaccaria**). Here follows the timetable. Tickets from S. Zaccaria to San Servolo cost €1.80. Other routes (excluding Grand Canal) cost €3.50 one way, or € 6.00 return. **The most economic option is to buy a daily (€10,5) or a 3-day pass (€22) that serves for all public transport in Venice.** It can be bought at every boat stop. From the airport

There are several services that run from the airport to Venice:

- ✓ **Alilaguna waterbus service:** this company offers a service that goes from the airport to Murano, the Lido, the Arsenale with a final stop at San Marco. Tickets cost €10.00, and can be purchased in the arrival hall of the airport or directly on board. Boats leave hourly. Take shuttle bus from terminal to dock (<http://www.alilaguna.it/>).
- ✓ **ATVO buses:** these blue buses run hourly from the airport to Piazzale Roma and they leave from in front of the entrance of the departure hall. Tickets cost €2.70 and can be purchased at the ATVO stand in the arrival hall or directly on board. The service runs from 9.00 to 24.00 and takes about 20 minutes to reach Venice (<http://www.atvo.it/airport.php>)
- ✓ **ACTV Public bus n°5:** these orange buses run every half hour. The last stop is "Piazzale Roma". Tickets cost €1.00 and can be purchased from the tobacconist inside the departure hall. The service takes about 25 minutes to reach "Piazzale Roma".

By car

If you bring a car to Venice, you will have to pay for a garage or parking space during your stay. The last stops in Venice where you can leave your car are called "Piazzale Roma" and "Tronchetto". Parking at "Piazzale Roma" in the parking lot run by the city costs between €7.7 and €12.90, and at the private Garage San Marco (next door) it costs between €20.00 and €24.00 for 24 hours, depending on the size of the car. To reach the privately run "Tronchetto" parking area, as you come into Venice, follow the signs and turn right before "Piazzale Roma". Warning: Do not be waylaid by illegal touts - often wearing fake uniforms - who may try to flag you down and offer to arrange parking and hotels. Instead, continue on until you reach the automatic ticket machines. Parking here costs around €18.00 for 24 hours. (Do not leave valuables in the car. There is a luggage deposit office, open daily 8 a.m. - 8 p.m., next to the Pullman Bar on the ground floor of the municipal garage at "Piazzale Roma".) Another solution is to park your car in front of the train station in Mestre. Parking here costs much less (around €4 per day), and there are frequent trains and buses between Mestre and Venice Piazzale Roma

From the train station to San Zaccaria:

There are several public boats from the train station to San Zaccaria. You must take either the n°1 (tourists, more than 30 minutes), n°41 or n°51 (faster, about 20 minutes), and get off at the San Zaccaria boat stop. At San Zaccaria to get to San Servolo you must change to line n°20.

From Piazzale Roma to San Zaccaria:

There are several public boats from Piazzale Roma to San Zaccaria. You must take either the n°1 (tourists, more than 30 minutes), n°41, n°51 or n°61 (faster, about 20 minutes), and get off at the San Zaccaria boat stop. At San Zaccaria to get to San Servolo you must change to line n°20.

From Tronchetto to San Zaccaria:

You must take either the n°82, and get off at the San Zaccaria boat stop. At San Zaccaria to get to San Servolo you must change to line n°20.

ACCOMMODATION

Rooms have been reserved at "Fondazione Levi" (San Marco 2894, San Vidal, phone: +39041-2770542); at "Istituto Artigianelli" (Dorsoduro, 909/A, Fondamenta Zattere, phone +39041-5224077) and at "Foresteria San Servolo" (San Servolo Island, phone +39041-2765001).

How to get the hotels

To get to "Fondazione Levi", from the train station and Piazzale Roma take boat n°1; from Tronchetto take boat n°82. With either line get off at the boat stop Accademia and cross the Accademia bridge. To get to Istituto Artigianelli from the train station and Piazzale Roma take boat n°51 or 61; from Tronchetto take boat n°82. With either line get off at the boat stop Zattere. To get to the Island of San Servolo follow the instruction: **How to get to the workshop**. Other information can be found at:

From “Fondazione Levi” to San Servolo

To reach San Zaccaria (the boat stop where you can get boat n°20 to San Servolo) from “Fondazione Levi” you may either walk for 15 minutes (direction San Marco) or take boat n°1 at Accademia and get off at San Zaccaria.

From “Istituto Artigianelli” to San Servolo

To reach San Zaccaria (the boat stop where you can get boat n°20 to San Servolo) from “Istituto Artigianelli” take boat n°51 get off at San Zaccaria.

FOOD

GUIDED TOUR

The island of San Servolo was originally the home of the Venetian Calbana family who, beginning in 810, hosted the seat of a Benedictine Monastery. The buildings of the island have been developed and changed over the ages along with the people who inhabited it. San Servolo remained a monastery until the mid-eighteenth century when it was transformed into a Psychiatric Hospital until 1978. Now the Island is property of the “Provincia di Venezia” and hosted “Fondazione IRSCESC” and “Venice International University” (<http://www.sanservolo.provincia.venezia.it/>).

Thursday 16, from 11.30 to 12.30 we organize a **guided tour** to the Island. The meeting point is at the entrance of the Monumental Complex (just in front of the boat arrival). After the visit we can have lunch at the Cafeteria.
